BUSINESS LICENSE

Above is a sample of a City of Lansing Peddler License. Anyone coming to your home as a peddler should be able to show you their license bearing their name and picture. If they cannot show you a valid license, they are violating City Ordinance. While the City Clerk's Office is responsible for processing the licenses, the Lansing Police Department is the enforcing agency. The non-emergency number for LPD is 517-483-4600.

Peddler means and includes any person, whether a resident of the City or not, traveling by foot, wagon, automotive vehicle or any other type of conveyance, from place to place, from house to house or from street to street, carrying, conveying or transporting goods, wares, merchandise, meats, fish, vegetables, fruits, garden trucks or farm products or provisions, offering and exposing the same for sale, or making sales and delivering articles to purchasers, or, without traveling from place to place, selling or offering the same for sale from a wagon, automotive vehicle, railroad car or other vehicle or conveyance. A person who solicits orders and as a separate transaction makes deliveries to purchasers as a part of a scheme or design to evade the provisions of Sections 844.01 to 844.18 shall be deemed a peddler. "Peddler" includes "hawker" and "huckster."
