A grant from the State of Michigan, combined with community, support will ensure this project's success.

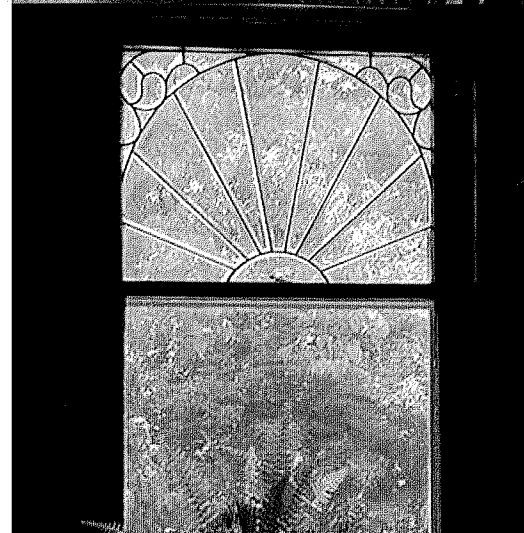
You have an opportunity to become part of this historic project by purchasing a brick in the new garden walkway.
