



SCHEDULE A

Building Permit Fee Schedule

July 1, 2011

The following fees shall be charged for new construction, additions, alterations and repairs. The determination of value or valuation under any of the provisions of this Code shall be made by the Manager of the Building Safety Office. The valuation to be used in computing the permit fee shall be the total value of all construction work for which the permit is issued, as well as all finish work, painting, roofing, electrical plumbing, heating, air conditioning, elevators, fire-extinguishing systems and any other permanent work or permanent equipment.

\$1.00 to \$2,000	\$60.00
\$2001 to \$4,000	\$80.00
\$4,001 to \$10,000	\$115.00
\$10,001 to \$15,000	\$160.00
\$15,001 to \$50,000	\$160.00 for the first \$15,000 plus \$7.50 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof, to and including \$50,000.
\$50,001 to \$1,000,000	\$422.50 for the first \$50,000 plus \$6.50 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof, to and including \$1,000,000.
\$1,000,001 to \$5,000,000	\$6,597.50 for the first \$1,000,000 plus \$5.25 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof, to and including \$5,000,000.
\$5,000,001 to \$10,000,000	\$27,597.50 for the first \$5,000,000 plus \$4.25 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof, to and including \$10,000,000.
\$10,000,001 and up	\$48,847.50 for the first \$10,000,000 plus \$3.00 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof.

The fee shall be based upon the estimated valuation established by multiplying the square footage of the building by a reasonable unit cost factor or by such other method or methods established and approved by the Building Official. Such cost factors shall be posted in the Building Safety Office. No permit shall be issued upon a lesser value than determined from this table.

The most recent square foot cost data provided by the International Conference of Building Officials shall be used in determining building permit value. The square footage used to determine value shall be the floor area within the external dimensions of the building.

Plan Review Fees

Residential (R-3, One & Two Family Homes Only) Structures:

Permits having a work value of \$5,000 or less are exempt from Plan Review Fees. Plan Review Fees for Permits for **new construction** with a valuation of \$50,000 or less shall be 10% of the Building Permit Fee. Plan Review Fees for permits with a valuation greater than \$50,000 in value shall be 20% of the Building Permit Fee. Plan Review Fees for **additions and alterations** (the reconfiguring of space or the adding of finished space) to existing building shall be 5% of the Building Permit Fee. Plan Review Fees will not be collected on repair, siding, and roofing permits.

Commercial and Multi-Family Structures:

When construction documents and/or other data are required to be submitted in accordance with the Michigan Building Code, a Plan Review Fee shall be paid at the time of submitting plans and specifications for review. Said Plan Review Fee shall be **55%** of the Building Permit Fee as shown in the Building Permit Fee Table. Plan Review includes original submission plus one revision. Additional reviews prior to issuance of the permit will be billed at \$100.00 per hour with a one hour minimum and in ½ hour increments over one hour. Review of Revisions, Addendums, Architect's Supplemental Instructions, and Change Orders etc., submitted after the issuance of the permit (other than deferred submittals noted in original plan review), will be billed at \$100.00 per hour with a one hour minimum and in ½ hour increments over one hour.

Miscellaneous Fees

Technology Fee applies to all building permits: \$ **5.00**
Additional Inspection Fee: \$ **60.00**

Siding Installation Permit Fee for: aluminum, vinyl, steel, or wood siding; when repair, remodel or residing on or residential buildings. \$ **60.00**
 Commercial is based on the VALUE OF WORK

Tear Off and Re-roof: Single Family/Residential \$ **70.00**
 Commercial is based on the VALUE OF WORK

Demolition Permit Fee to Demolish Buildings and Structures:

Private garages, sheds \$ **60.00**
 Dwelling or Dwelling with garage \$ **80.00**
 Warehouses, factories, stores and office buildings: 10,000 Sq. Ft. \$ **150.00**
 > 10,000 Sq. Ft. \$ **500.00**

Moving Permit Fee to Move Buildings and Structures:

All buildings and structures less than 500 square feet in area and less than 17 feet high when loaded. \$ **50.00**
 All buildings over 500 square feet in area over 17 feet high. \$ **125.00**
 Police Escort Fee: \$ **250.00**

Swimming Pool Installation Fee: \$ **60.00**

Board of Appeals/Administrative Modifications: Single Family Residential \$ **125.00**
 Commercial \$ **200.00**
 Single Family Residential Rentals \$ **200.00**

Administrative Search Warrant: \$ **200.00**

Safety Inspections: Structural safety inspections of existing buildings for resale purposes, including a letter listing any corrections needed shall be performed on receipt of a written request and by payment of a fee, payable prior to issuance of said inspection report. **\$100.00**

Refund of Fees: Holders of permits upon which work has not been started may make written application for a refund of Fees paid for such Permits, provided such application is made by the same person or corporation who originally applied for such permit or by the estate of such person or receiver of such corporation within 6 months of date of issue. Upon verifying the facts in such cases, the Building Safety Manager shall refund 75% of all fees in excess of \$5.00 in such manner as may be directed by the City Controllers.
