HOMELESS PREVENTION AND RAPID RE-HOUSING (HPRP)

The Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Fund will provide financial assistance and services to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless and to help those who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized. The funds under this program are intended to target individuals and families who would be homeless but for this assistance. The funds will provide a variety of assistance including: short-term or medium-term rental assistance and housing relocation and stabilization services, including such activities as mediation, credit counseling, security or utility deposits, utility payments, moving cost assistance and case management.

Eligible Program Participants: Homeless persons and persons at risk of becoming homeless, who meet the following three criteria: (1) Any individual or family receiving rental assistance must have at least an initial consultation with a case manager to determine need (2) Household must be at or below 50% of the Area Median Income (AMI) (3) Household must meet both of the following circumstances: (a) no appropriate housing options have been identified; and (b) the household lacks the financial resources and support networks needed to obtain immediate housing. The budget for the City of Lansing's Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing (HPRP) program is **\$898,823**.

In April 2009, the City of Lansing prepared the HPRP amendment defining the proposed activities administered by Capital Area Community Services (CACS) and Legal Services of South Central Michigan (LCSCM). The purpose of this amendment is to shift dollars in the HPRP budget for CACS. Specifically, the initial budget was an estimate and community needs revealed more dollars were needed for financial assistance and housing relocation and stabilization services in the area of homeless prevention vs. rapid re-housing.

A copy of the existing and proposed budget amendment for Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing (HPRP) program funds will be available for public review and comment at the City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development, 316 N. Michigan Ave, and at the Capital Area District Library (Reference Desk, 2nd flr.), 401 S. Capitol Ave, Lansing, MI. The comment period for the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing (HPRP) program funds will commence at **8:00 a.m. on December 22, 2010 and expire at 5:00 p.m. January 4, 2011**.

All written comments submitted by citizens of Lansing will be reviewed and considered. The Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing (HPRP) Action Plan subsequent amendment to the substantial amendment will be submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development no later than **January 7, 2011**. A summary of all comments received will be attached to the final document.
