What is a Charrette?

A charrette is a workshop held to specifically gather input from a variety of stakeholders on a design initiative. A charrette can focus on a single project or a community wide plan like a Master Plan. A typical charrette creates an open and comfortable environment for all members to participate for an effective outcome. The charrette will involve participants in the design challenge at hand, and provide the tools for participants to engage in meaningful, realistic community planning. The goal of the charrette will be to create a design, based on shared guiding principles and anchored with realistic constraints. The design plan will consider all viewpoints, resulting in broad support from community members, professionals and staff.

Agenda for the *Design Lansing* Master Plan Charrette

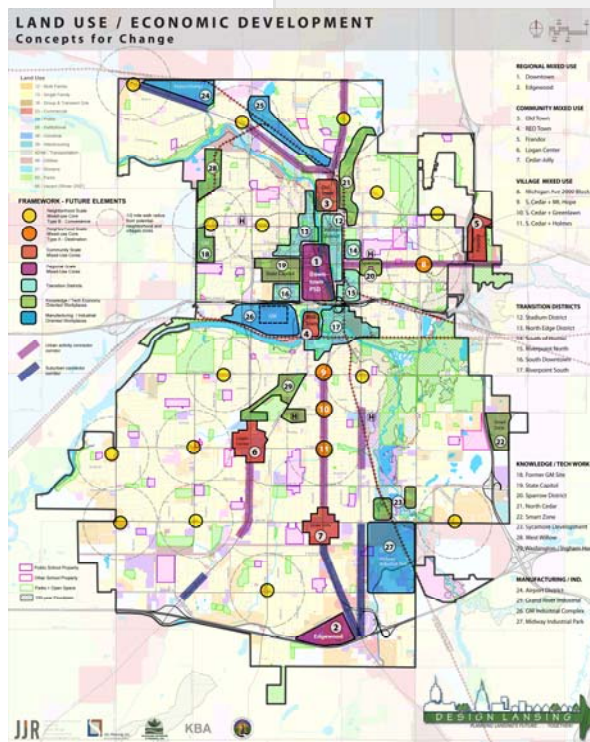
9-9:30 Introductions, view materials and maps, light refreshments will be available.
