CSO Traffic Updates and Construction Progress

Downtown – Allegan/Chestnut

- Allegan closed to through traffic between Grand and Washington; businesses are open
- Chestnut closed to through traffic between Ottawa and Shiawassee; the intersection of Ionia and Chestnut is open; businesses are open
- The intersection of Allegan and Washington is expected to close beginning June 24
- Sanitary and storm sewer installation complete on Allegan between Grand and Washington; sewer lead connections underway
- Water service connections completed on Chestnut between Ottawa and Shiawassee
- Storm and sanitary sewer installation complete on Chestnut between Ottawa and Ionia; storm and sanitary sewer installation underway from Ionia to Shiawassee

018SW – Center/Cedar/May

- Cedar closed to through traffic from Grand River to Oakland; businesses are open and detours are posted
- Curb and gutter, driveways and sidewalks installed on Adams
- Storm sewer installation complete on Cedar; water main construction expected to begin week of June 22
- Water main installation complete on Maple between Cedar and Larch
- Water main construction complete on Ash between Cedar and Larch; sanitary sewer installation is underway

045 – Saginaw/Pennsylvania

- North lanes of Saginaw between Center and Cleveland closed and traffic shifted to the south lanes; Prudden access off of Saginaw reopened; businesses are open and detours are posted
- Road construction forthcoming on Saginaw Access and East Park Terrace
- Water main construction nearly complete on Saginaw between Pennsylvania and Cleveland; Storm sewer construction is now underway

034A – Cooper/Poxson

- Curb, driveway approach, sidewalk replacement and parkway restoration complete on Cooper between Osband and MLK Jr
- Gravel road base placed on Cooper between Osband and MLK Jr; paving is expected to be completed the week of June 22
- Water main installation underway on Woodbine between Stirling and MLK Jr
- Base paving and parkway restoration completed on Kelsey and on Stirling between Rundle and Woodbine

013NE – Creston/Howe

- Sanitary sewer installation complete on Seventh between Chilson and Paulson; road construction underway and paving is scheduled week of June 22
- Base paving complete on Orchard Glen between N East and Garland, Paulson between N East and Garland, as well as Hunt between Chilson and Paulson; parkway restoration ongoing
- Water main installation continuing on Creston north from Howe intersection
- Sanitary sewer and storm sewer construction complete on Howe between Turner and Creston
- Sanitary sewer installation underway on Walker between Frederick and Sheridan

015N – Willow/Chestnut

- Willow closed to through traffic from Grand River to Knollwood; businesses are open and detours are posted
- Storm sewer and temporary water main installation complete on Chestnut north of Willow; sanitary trunk sewer installation underway and should conclude week of June 22
- Temporary water main construction complete on Chestnut south of Willow
- Water main construction complete on Lemrork; water service installation underway
- Sanitary sewer service connections complete on Willow between Knollwood and Lemrork
- Water main construction complete on Willow between Grand River and Chestnut; water service connections underway
- Completed sanitary and storm manholes and sanitary service connections on Willow west of Lemrork

034B – Mt Hope

- Project expected to begin in late June

Non-CSO Street and Bridge Construction Progress

Aurelius Road Bridge

- The Aurelius Road Bridge over the Red Cedar, north of Mt Hope will be closed for deck replacement starting June 22 and lasting through September
- The road will be closed to traffic at Mt Hope and at Main
- Access to the parking lot at Kruger's Landing will be maintained
- The Rivertrail underneath the bridge will be closed; pedestrian and bicycle traffic will be rerouted south of the bridge on the rivertrail to cross on Aurelius
- Aurelius is currently being used as an alternate travel route by many commuters avoiding the US-127 lane closures; MDOT reports that the US-127 project is slightly ahead of schedule and the work necessitating the daytime lane closures on US-127 should be complete by June 22

Local Street Resurfacing Project

- Work continues on this project, which began in 2008
- Work is complete on Byrnes, Beacon Hill and Colchester
- Resurfacing is taking place on Bedford, Cambridge, Westchester and East Westchester, north of Mt. Hope near Moores River, and on Indiana and Leon
- Next week, work will begin on Ohio and Vermont
- Other streets to be completed in this project include Artisan, Callihan and Stoneleigh, Park and Pattengill
