015N – Oakland

- Oakland is closed to through traffic between Walnut and Martin Luther King Jr.; businesses are open and detours are posted.
- Walnut is closed to through traffic at the intersection of Oakland; detour is posted.
- Water main has been installed on Oakland between Pine and Walnut; testing is complete and services are installed. Main line sewers are being installed.
- Water main has been installed on Wisconsin between Daleford and Oakland; testing is complete and services are installed.
- Water main has been installed on Daleford between Princeton and Sycamore; testing is complete and services are installed. Main line sewer installation will begin in the next two weeks.
- Water main has been installed on Brook between State and Pine; testing is complete and services are installed. Main line sewers are being installed.
- Temporary water main has been installed on Sycamore between Daleford and Brook; testing is complete and services are installed. Main line sewer installation will begin this week.

Non-CSO Construction Projects

- **Kalamazoo (between Larch and Pennsylvania):** Road reconstruction began on April 18. Old concrete and pavement have been removed from the north side of the roadway. Storm sewer construction is underway. One-way, eastbound traffic is being maintained on the south side. Westbound traffic follows the posted detour. The project is expected to be complete by mid-July.
- **Jolly (between Aurelius and Dunckel):** Construction for mill and resurfacing began on May 9. Bridge deck repair is in progress. The project is expected to be complete by mid-June. Two-way traffic is being maintained with one lane in each direction.
- **Pennsylvania (between Cedar and Miller):** It is a mill and resurface project. Construction for mill and resurfacing began on May 9. Concrete work on sidewalk ramps and curb and gutter is in progress. The project is expected to be complete by early July. Two-way traffic is being maintained with one lane in each direction.
- **Bridge Rehabilitation (Pennsylvania over the Red Cedar River):** This project is a continuation from the 2010 season. The date to resume work has not been determined.
