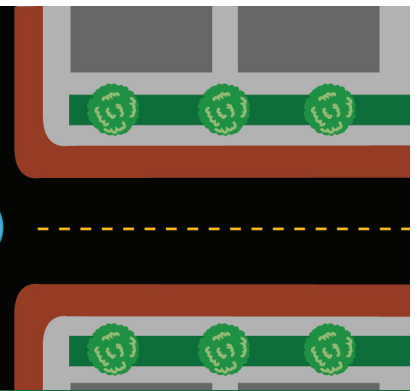

015N – Oakland

- Oakland is closed to through traffic between Walnut and Martin Luther King, Jr.; businesses are open and detours are posted.
- Walnut is closed to through traffic at the intersection of Oakland; detour is posted.
- Main line sanitary sewer has been completed on Oakland between Pine and Walnut; all remaining utility services will be complete within two weeks; road building to begin this week.
- Road surface removal has been completed on Oakland between Wisconsin and Martin Luther King, Jr.; water main and sanitary sewer installation to begin within two weeks.
- Sanitary sewer installation has been completed on Wisconsin between Daleford and Oakland; storm sewer installation, followed by road construction, will begin in two weeks.
- Storm sewer installation, followed by road construction, will begin on Daleford between Sycamore and Wisconsin in two weeks.
- Water main installation has been completed on Brook between State and Sycamore.
- Water main has been installed on Sycamore between Daleford and Brook.
- All utility installation has been completed on Brook and Sycamore; road building to begin this week.

Non-CSO Construction Projects

- **Kalamazoo (between Larch and Pennsylvania):** The road bed is being constructed and preparations are being made for curb and gutter installation on the north side of the road; storm sewer construction is complete; one lane of eastbound traffic is being maintained; westbound traffic follows the posted detour.; expected completion by mid-July.
- **Jolly (between Aurelius and Dunckel):** Project is nearly complete; intermittent lane closures will be in effect until project completion.
- **Pennsylvania (between Cedar and Miller):** Concrete work on sidewalk ramps and curb and gutter is in progress; expected completion by early July; two-way traffic is being maintained with one lane open for southbound traffic.
- **Turner Street (between Carrier Street and Sheridan Road):** Road reconstruct on Turner will begin June 13; intersection of Turner and Sheridan will be closed at project start; intersection to reopen in mid-July; project completion by the end of July.
