Shooting suspect ARRESTED / ARRAIGNED

On Tuesday 2/20/18 at approximately 7:45 p.m. Lansing Police were dispatched to a residence in the 900 block of W. Shiawassee on a shooting. Responding Officers were informed by Ingham County dispatch a female had been shot and the male shooter ran off.

Upon arrival Officers made contact with a 39 year old female (victim) with an apparent gunshot wound to her arm. The victim was transported to a local hospital with a non-life threatening injury.

Officers on scene investigation determined the victim and the suspect are in a relationship. This evening the victim and suspect were in their residence having a verbal argument. During the argument the suspect shot the victim and left on foot.

Assisting Officers along with Violent Crime Initiative Officers were able to develop information on the suspect and his whereabouts. Within a short time period the suspect was located in the 700 block of Chicago and arrested without incident. The suspect, a 35 year old Lansing man was transported to the Lansing Police Detention facility and held.

Detailed investigative reports with regard to this crime were completed and given to the Ingham County Prosecutor for review on issuing criminal charges.

This afternoon criminal charges were issued on the suspect and he was subsequently arraigned in 54-A District court in front of Judge Clarke on the following;

CHARGE:

Count 1: Assault with Intent to Murder (Felony)

Count 1: Weapons – Firearms – Possession by Felon (FELONY)

Count 2: Weapons – Felony Firearm (FELONY)

Habitual Offender – 2nd Offense

BOND: \$100,000.00 Cash / Surety

Preliminary Hearing: 3/9/18 @ 9:30 a.m.
