UPDATE: BODY RECOVERED FROM THE GRAND RIVER

On March 10, 2018 at approximately 9:21 a.m., Lansing Police Department officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Willow Ave., on report of a possible body in the Grand River. Arriving patrol officers located a body submerged in the water on the banks of the Grand River at the northern most point of Washington Ave at Willow Ave.

Members of the Capital Area Dive Team and investigators from the Lansing Police Department responded to facilitate recovery of the body. The body was recovered and appears to be a white male in his mid-twenties however, positive identity has not established.

Based upon the height, weight, and clothing of the recovered deceased, preliminary indications suggest the body to be that of the missing 24 year old, male, kayaker that fell into the Grand River on February 27, 2018.

The body was released to the Ingham County Medical Examiner pending an autopsy and positive identity of the deceased.

No further updates will be provided until Monday, March 12th.
