Shooting / Arrest / Arraignment

On Saturday 3/10/18 at approximately 12:56 a.m. Lansing Police were dispatched to a shooting in the 4400 block of S. Martin L. King (Liquor King convenience store) Lansing, MI.

Upon arrival Officers locate two male subjects (victims, 25 yrs. & 23 yrs.) with apparent gunshot wounds. Both victims were provided with first aid until Lansing Fire Department medics arrived and took over. Both victims were transported to a local hospital and are in critical but stable condition.

On scene investigating Officers were given suspect information and description. Within a short time period Officers located the suspect who was near the shooting incident. The suspect was arrested without incident. Officers located and recovered the handgun the suspect used in the shooting. The suspect was transported to the Lansing Police Detention facility.

Officers and investigators were able to ascertain the following; suspect and the victims arrive to the business separately and got in to a verbal argument that turned physical, leading to the suspect shooting the two victims.

Detailed investigative reports were completed with regard to the above crime and submitted to the Ingham County Prosecutors office for review on criminal charges.

This afternoon criminal charges were issued on the suspect, who subsequently arraigned in 54-A District court in front of Magistrate Millmore on the following;

Andrufus Sharquan Daywatkins, 22 year old Lansing man

CHARGE:

Count 1: Assault with intent to Murder (Felony)

Count 2: Assault with intent to Murder (Felony)

Count 3: Carrying Concealed Weapon (Felony)

Count 4: Armed Robbery citizen (Felony)

Count 5: Weapons – Felony Firearm (Felony)

BOND: \$500,000.00 Cash/Surety

Daywatkins is next scheduled in 54-A District court in front of Judge Buchanan on;

Probable Cause hearing: 3/23/18 @ 9:00 a.m.

Preliminary Hearing: 3/29/18 @ 8:30 a.m.
