Felonious Assault / Arrest / Arraignment

Lansing Police were dispatched yesterday (4/19/18) @ 6:45 p.m. to a large fight in the 2100 block of W. Hillsdale (St. Joe Park). Upon arrival Officers observed many people that appeared to have been fighting. Officers made contact and began to interview and obtain statements.

The investigation discovered there had been an ongoing dispute between two families. Both families' met at this location. A verbal altercation turned physical among some of the members. Of the fighting were two females, a 33 year old (Victim) and a 32 year (Suspect). After the physical altercation the suspect entered her vehicle and drove it toward the victim striking her on two occasions. The suspect then left the scene. The victim was transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries and is in stable condition.

On scene Officers investigation developed leads on the whereabouts of the suspect and her vehicle. Assisting Officers locate the vehicle and suspect in the 1800 block of Rundle and arrest her without incident. The suspect was transported to the Lansing Detention Facility and held.

Detailed reports with regard to the above crime were completed and submitted to the Ingham County Prosecutor for review on criminal charges.

This afternoon charges were issued on the suspect who was subsequently arraigned in 54-A District court in front of Magistrate Millmore on the following;

Vaneeka Denise Shelton (32 yrs. / Lansing, MI)

CHARGE:

Count 1: Assault with a Dangerous Weapon / Felonious Assault (Felony)

Count 2: Assault with a Dangerous Weapon / Felonious Assault (Felony)

BOND: \$5,000.00 / 10%

Shelton is next scheduled in 54-A District court in front of Judge Clarke on;

Probable Cause hearing: 5/4/18 @ 8:30 a.m.

Preliminary Hearing: 5/11/18 @ 8:30 a.m.
