WHAT IS SCHOOL WATCH?

- Lansing School Watch (LSW) is a citizen volunteer program between the Lansing Police Department, Sparrow Health Systems and the community as a whole working together to help detect and prevent crime against our students and schools.
- LSW is modeled after our effective Neighborhood and Business Watch Programs.
- The LSW program will help our schools and the surrounding neighborhoods constructively handle the crime and violence that occurs outside of school property and in our neighborhoods.
- The strategic focus of LSW shall be the enhancement of community safety through a problem-solving approach to crime and disorder affecting our schools and neighborhoods.



SCHOOL WATCH MISSION

The Lansing School Watch sends volunteers into the neighborhoods surrounding Lansing schools to act as “eyes and ears” for the Lansing Police Department. Their role adds another layer of security for our students and neighborhoods. Lansing School Watch will act as an observation and reporting program assisting the Lansing Police Department and our community as a whole.
