**SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARATION**

On January 28, 2019, the City of Lansing, Michigan, is receiving heavy snow accumulation from a snow storm that is moving through the area and expected to continue throughout the day. The snow fall is expected to continue through the evening with expected totals of 10 plus inches of snow. This snow storm has made streets and roads within the City of Lansing unsafe for motorists and is reducing access for emergency vehicles.

- Implementation of an emergency vehicle access plan to support police, fire and EMS personnel responding to 911 calls for assistance.
- Implementation of a snow removal and ice management plan for all city streets, roads and right-of-ways.
- Implementation of a community-wide critical communications plan.

As a result of this situation, the following conditions exist:


- Emergency services may be delayed.
- Roads may be restricted or impassable.
- Public transportation may be restricted.
- Essential government services will be operating under a local declaration of a snow emergency.

Until further notice the following emergency orders are in effect:

- Non-essential commercial, private and public travel on city roads is prohibited.
- Parking on all unplowed city streets is prohibited.
- All City of Lansing sponsored events or meetings are cancelled.

Therefore, as Mayor of the City of Lansing, in accordance with Section 10 of Act 390, P.A. 1976, as amended and the City of Lansing Municipal Ordinance Chapter 234, "Emergency Management", I hereby declare that a "Snow Emergency" exists therein, and the response and recovery aspects of the emergency operations plan have been activated, and that local resources are being utilized to the fullest extent possible.
