# Update: Income Tax Payment Locations

**(LANSING)** – Due to the local State of Emergency declaration in response to the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic, the City of Lansing’s Treasury and Income Tax office in City Hall is closed. The department is still processing and operating; however, employees are not in the office to take payments.

### **Income Tax Payments can be made:**

- **In Person:** Payments can be dropped off into the Treasury and Income Tax drop box located on the Capital Avenue side of City Hall (124 W. Michigan Avenue).
- **By Mail:** Payments can be sent via regular mail to Lansing City Treasurer, P.O. Box 40752, Lansing, MI 48901.
- **Online:** Payments can be made online at [www.lansingmi.gov/onlinepayment](http://www.lansingmi.gov/onlinepayment) – You will need your file number or the last four digits of your social security number in order to complete this payment. Checking accounts and credit cards are accepted.
- **Phone:** Credit card payments can be made by calling 1-855-474-4076. If assistance is needed to complete the process, call Point & Pay’s Customer Service Department at 1-888-891-6064.
- **Payment Plans/Arrest Warrants/Settlement Agreements:** These plans are being handled by the Income Tax Investigator who can be reached at 517-483-4103.

Please note that property taxes for 2019 are considered delinquent now and can only be made at the Ingham County Treasurer’s Office in Mason, Michigan.
