

City of Lansing Marijuana Update

April 8, 2020

Wednesday, April 15 is still the last day to submit marijuana operation applications for this 30-day window. There is no change in the schedule dates.

The next 30 day window will open on April 21. As you can see the schedule below in red, we have added to the acceptance window applications for Microbusinesses in Ward 2 and Ward 3 only. To see the Ward Map, visit lansingmi.gov/marijuana.

The City of Lansing has yet to reach the limit set by the Ordinance for the number of grow locations city-wide. The City Clerk can license **more grow locations for either adult use, medical, or both.**

If the Clerk's Office receives less than the cap in grow applications at new locations by the April 15 deadline, then we will resume accepting grow applications for new locations starting on April 21. There is no cap on grow licenses at current locations. We will send an update as soon as we make a determination.

There are **no** new Adult Use Retail or Medical Provisioning Center locations available, all 28 locations have been determined. If you are an applicant for a Medical Provisioning Centers and would like to add Adult Use Retail to their location or an Adult Use Retail locations and want to co-locate a Medical Provisioning Center, you may apply in the next 30 day window which opens April 21.

Please be aware that the Mayor Andy Schor has declared a local State of Emergency in Lansing in response to the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic. The Clerk's Office has transition to working remotely which may delay the review and processing of applications, and change other procedures. We have been creative in avoiding face to face interactions with both the public and staff in order to do our part to keep our families/community/state/world safe.

The enrollment period windows for the rest of 2020 is posted. These 30-day periods are subject to change, but the Clerk's Office will provide as much notice as possible if any adjustments are made. Revisions made in the enrollment period compared to any past updates schedule are in red.

Online submission is required for all types of Marijuana Operation applications. Paper applications will not be accepted.

Application review will not begin until non-refundable payment is received.

As you review the General Instructions for the operation type of interest to you, please note the importance of reviewing the submission confirmation email, and that elements of the business plan need the documents to be split into specific sections to expedite the review process.

You may need to upload the same attachment to multiple sections of the application as the City Clerk will only review the documents submitted for each category.

Additional documents cannot be submitted once an application is denied.
