

M-99 (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) Pavement Repairs Lansing

Mid-May - June 2020

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will complete the \$4.6 million project to perform pavement repairs and preventive maintenance on M-99 (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) between Edgewood Boulevard/Pleasant Grove Boulevard and Victor Avenue in Lansing. Work is expected to begin after mid-May and be finished in June.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Traffic will be maintained throughout the project. One lane will always be open in each direction. There will be nighttime construction that will require closing the center three lanes; both outside lanes will remain open.
