Homer Street lane reduction in Lansing begins on Monday

COUNTY:

PROJECT:

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest about \$200,000 to reduce Homer Street from three lanes to two lanes and replace the water main next to the Frandor shopping center in Lansing. Crews will remove the far right lane between Vine Street and the northbound US-127 exit to M-43 (East Saginaw Street) in order to improve sight distance for turning traffic along Homer Street. This project is funded through MDOT's Safety Program.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS:

Traffic will be maintained throughout the project. Single and double-lane closures will be in place along Homer Street as necessary to complete the work.

SAFETY BENEFITS:
